







I am aware of my child's needs and how their needs are supported in School


We received **31** responses to the Annual SEND Consultation Form, this represents 62% **of pupils** currently on our SEND register at Sherwood. The narrative within the report provides a response to your written feedback. Thank you again, Mrs K Hobson, SENDCO.

I have watched my child grow and excel academically and I know the staff at Sherwood has put in so much effort through the years to support my child's needs. 
Parent/Carer Feedback: It's a little more tricky to get that super quick time to chat with the Y1 teachers in comparison to foundation, but that is because all the children are coming in and out at the same time and through the same entrance. As foundation was split and staggered we could easily have a quick chat with the teacher at the gate for quick queries.

School response: Thank you for your feedback. We will review the supervision of Y1 children at the end of the day to support our class teachers in providing more opportunities for discussion more frequently.


I feel that I have sufficient information and communication about my child's progress

Parent/Carer Feedback: More updates on our child's progress would be good. Appreciate this can't be every day/week but outside parents' evenings, the only time we are approached is if there has any been anything negative. It would be nice to have at least every 2/3 weeks a couple of minutes just to be updated. Thank you.

School response: Thank you, we welcome this feedback and will look to put this regular update in place moving forward.

Parent/Carer Feedback: It would be nice to have access to wider useful technology to assist my child's reading/writing with dyslexia.

School response: We are currently exploring the introduction of a touchtyping course for children with specific barriers to learning. More information to follow in 2025.

Parent/Carer Feedback: I am very happy with the strategies put in place for our child in the classroom and the advice and guidance offered to how best we can support his transition to high school.
