- E** Hand **e**mbroider your own picture or create an **e**-card.
- F** Write 100 words explaining how the Arts give you **f**reedom or perform your own **f**ashion show.
- G** Dance to the *Peer Gynt Suite 'In the Hall of the Mountain King'* by Edvard **G**rieg or design and make your own family board **g**ame.
- H** **H**ot seat your favourite character from a book.
- I** Design and make your own musical **i**nstrument or **i**llustrate your favourite book.
- J** Watch *Flash Mob - Gustav Holst - The Planets: Jupiter*. Name the instruments and describe how the music makes you feel. What is name of the well-known 1921 hymn?
- K** Build and fly your own **k**ite or recreate your own *Tree of Life* by Gustav **K**limt.
