



CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH



Ancient Greek Myths and Monsters – A short story based on a myth.

We are going to continue exploring Greek Gods, Greek Myths and Greek Monsters today.

Read, watch and listen to the Greek myth 'Theseus and the Minotaur'.

Read: The attached copy of the myth – found on the remote learning page.

Task 2 – A short story based on a myth

Re-write the story using a maximum of 500 words. Every word counts so make sure you use exciting vocabulary and a range of sentences to excite and interest your reader.

Today we will be sticking with addition and subtraction, but moving onto decimals.

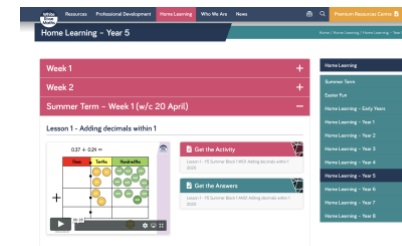
Log onto <https://www.whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-5/> and choose **Summer Term Week 1 (w/c 20th April)**.
