CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

CHILLY BILLY

Today we are going to start to read about Chilly Billy's adventures! The text has been uploaded along with a video of Miss Rimmer reading aloud on the year 2 remote learning page. This has been recorded in three parts. As well as reading, we also have two tasks for you to complete.

TASKS

1. Before reading, please write **5 questions** that you would like to ask Chilly Billy. Think about what we have read so far and what we know about Chilly Billy. Then, ask an adult to ask you the questions. You are going to answer the questions as Chilly Billy. Think about what Chilly Billy's answers would be by using what you know about him so far. Please record yourself answering your questions as Chilly Billy. Miss Rimmer and Miss Hough have modelled this for you. You can find the video on the year 2 remote learning page.

For example:

What is your favourite job inside the fridge?

2. You have been provided with 6 questions for you to answer based on the text. Miss Rimmer has created a video on the year 2 remote learning page to demonstrate how we would like you to answer the questions. We would like you to write your answers in full sentences and use the text to explain why.

For example:

1. Which vegetable did Chilly Billy think blinked at him?

Remember to always refer back to the text to show how fantastic you are at reading and responding!

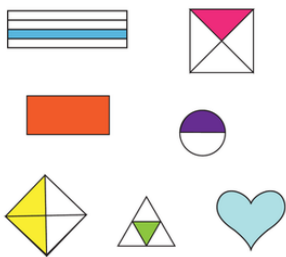
CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

This is the last day of our Fraction work for the week. We have been busy in class and at home finding and identifying a $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of amounts and shapes.

Today, in class, we are going to be looking at finding a quarter of shapes and amounts.

Please could you complete the following tasks based on this:

1. Please recap on what a quarter is. Can you look at the following sheet and identify which shape has been split into quarters:



Can you record yourself explaining how you know?

2. Please watch Miss Hough's video on finding a quarter of a shape and amount.
3. Please complete the following sheets which can be found on the Year 2 Remote Learning page:

Who has more? Explain why.

Rosie: I have $\frac{1}{4}$ of £8

Whitney: I have $\frac{1}{2}$ of £6

Mo has two ribbons. He cuts $\frac{1}{4}$ from each ribbon.

$\frac{1}{4}$ of ribbon A: 5 cm

$\frac{1}{4}$ of ribbon B: 4 cm

How long were Mo's whole pieces of ribbon?

Which ribbon was the longest? How much longer?
