Today we are looking at equivalent fractions. Two fractions that have the same value. Fractions walls are helpful to visualise this. See the fractions wall sheet on the website.

Today you will be taught to find equivalent fractions by looking at how we can change the denominator and numerator. For example, $\frac{6}{12}$ can be written more simply as $\frac{1}{2}$. This is called **reducing the fraction to its simplest form**.
